Wednesday, July 7, 2010

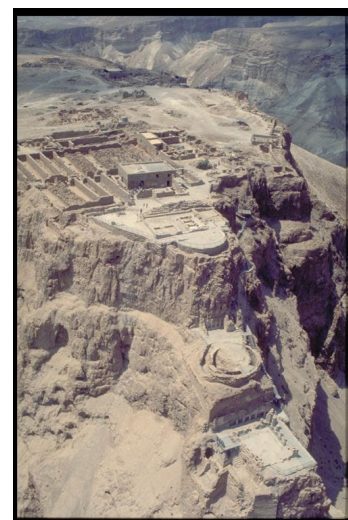
Full day tour to include stops at Nitzanim Research Site,
